TASTING NOTES

Dark cherry color with medium-high depth, with little brightness evolution. Intense liqueur red-berry fruit, cacao and nutmeg. When we swirl the glass some nuances of dried fruit and nuts appear, also some bay leaf and a few lactic notes. Juicy initial sensation with fresh tannins which persist as the wine passes through your mouth, accompanied by reminders of spices and dried fruit. The retro-nasal is fine and elegant with gentle and fresh tannins that invite you to repeat.

TIM ATKIN'S REVIEW

Released for the first time in 2013, this comes from a small valley in Villabuena and is a single vineyard wine in all but name. Combining Tempranillo with 10% Graciano it's a finely crafted, elegant wine with silky tannins and sweet oak.
