TASTING NOTES

The nose is elegant, showing aromas of red berries, touches of smoke and spices and Mediterranean aromatic herbs (thyme, rosemary) and a floral touch that adds elegance and some complexity. The palate is medium-bodied and harmonious with very pleasant, round tannins and moderate acidity. Very good value.

(made from 80 year-old bush vines and aged for eight months in new French oak): Bright ruby. Spicy, floral aromas of candied red berries, allspice, vanilla and incense. Bright and refreshing on the palate, offering sexy raspberry liqueur and floral pastille flavors underscored by a smoky mineral quality. There's something Pinot-like happening here. Closes with strong finishing cut and persistence, with silky tannins adding grip.
