TASTING NOTES

The grapes were picked by hand, from non-irrigated, moderately sloped vineyards. The 2009 vintage was a remarkable one, with a period starting in July and lasting well into October without even a trace of rain. Moderately warm days and long hang time resulted in perfectly ripe grapes, full of flavor. This wine was made primarily with the Wadenswil and Pommard clones of Pinot Noir. We obtain a "barrel select" bottling by tasting all the barrels from the vintage (81, in this case) and choosing 16-24 that we judge as superior. The wine had been aged in 50% new barrels, a mixture of French and American oak



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
